This crisp, focused, refreshing Charmat-process Italian sparkler made from 100% Glera (formerly called "Prosecco") offers fine bubbles along with lively lemony, toasty fruit in a very clean, very refreshing format. Although perfect on its own as an aperitif or with light nibbles, it is cheap enough to use as a base for a kir royale, bellini, mimosa, or other sparkling wine cocktail. For centuries, the people in the foothills around Mount Grappa produced large wheels of cheese cooperatively to preserve their milk and its nutrition. The cheese came to be known as Montegrappa whose texture is dense and yet yielding to the bite, slightly sweet, nutty and delicately salty. The flavor pairs well with seasonal ripe or dried fruit. It is no slouch in the kitchen either. It shaves nicely and melts very well, and can be used in any recipe calling for an Asiago type cheese.
